

The Education Bureau (EDB) announced on 31 August 2020 that, as the epidemic has shown signs of easing recently, and having regard to health experts' advice, EDB allows schools in Hong Kong to resume face-to-face classes in phases or arrange students to return to campus for learning activities for not longer than half a day from 16 September. Complying with the EDB's guideline, we have made the following arrangements:

1. Schedule and arrangements:

Remarks: a. The 'Half-day timetable' will be used until further notice. b. Students should wear the PE uniform to school if they have PE lessons on that day. c. Students will continue their online lessons until the face-to-face lessons of their class levels resume. d. F.1 orientation activities will be conducted in the first four lessons on 23/9 (Wed) and 24/9(Thu). F.1 students should wear P.E. uniform to school and do not need the textbooks for these lessons on 23/9 and 24/9.				

2. The classes will adopt half-day timetables and the students will take recess by batches in order to prevent crowd gathering of students of various levels.
3. In classrooms, students will sit in single row with a "face-to-back" setting and teachers would teach students who are facing one direction. The school would maximise the use of space in classrooms and in the school premises to ensure proper physical distances among students.
4. We are mindful of the rapidly changing nature of the COVID-19 pandemic and will keep in view the latest development, and parents should pay close attention to any latest announcements of our school as well as the EDB.
